The Head Start and Early Head Start programs serve low income and at risk families of pregnant moms and children through 4 years of age.

Virginia Preschool Initiative (VPI) serves low income and at risk 4 year olds.

We work with families to place children in locations that minimize transportation challenges and provide support where possible.

What do you need to register?

- ◆ Child's birth certificate or passport
- ◆ Proof of residency (lease, utility bill, letter from landlord)
- ◆ Proof of income (2 recent paystubs, letter from employer, 2018 tax form 1040 or 2018 W-2. Also include TANF, Social Security Income, Child Support and Alimony if applicable.
- ◆ Copy of your child's IEP/IFSP (if applicable)
- ◆ Medical Insurance Card



Our Early Childhood Programs offer:

- ◇ Early Childhood education in all areas of development (i.e. language, literacy, math, science, social and mediational, physical)
- ◇ Screening and assessment services for children
- ◇ Health and nutrition services, including oral health services
- ◇ Referrals for additional services based on family need through support from Family Service Specialists
- ◇ Opportunities for parents to participate on our Policy Council and Parent Committees
- ◇ Opportunities for parents to set goals related to their own educational and vocation plans

Our Early Head Start program provides services in three different settings to meet the individual needs of children and families:

CENTER-BASED SETTINGS located at George Washington Middle School and TC Williams High School. Children are enrolled in a full-day program designed to foster all aspects of development.

HOME-BASED SETTINGS On a weekly basis, a highly qualified Home Visitor Teacher visits families in their homes for 90 minutes, working with parents and children together to support all aspects of development.

FAMILY CHILD CARE The Campagna Center contracts with community-based family childcare providers who have made commitments to provide services that mirror the high standards of the Head Start program.
