Please bring these required documents. Without them we cannot complete your registration.

1. Copy of the child's birth certificate or passport (no birth letters)
2. Proof of income (both parents) 2 recent consecutive paystubs from current employers or a copy of your 2017 W2/1099 and signed tax return. Also include SSI, SSA, TANF and child support/alimony (if applicable).
3. Proof of Residency—copy of a lease, mortgage statement or utility bill (gas, water or electric only). If you are living with someone and your name is not on the lease, bring the lease and a notarized letter from the person on the lease stating you are living at that address.
4. Copy of your child's IEP/IFSP (if applicable)

Also requested at the time of registration:

1. Proof of Health Insurance
2. Physical Exam Form completed within the last 6 months and Dental Exam

The Head Start Program serves low-income families with children 3 to 5 years of age. Head Start offers children and families comprehensive early childhood experiences in an inclusive environment.

The Early Head Start Program serves low-income families of pregnant mothers to children 3 years of age in various settings to include center-based, family child care homes, and home-based in an inclusive environment.

Virginia Preschool Initiative (VPI) serves at risk 4 year olds. VPI offers children and families comprehensive early childhood experiences in an inclusive environment.

We work with families to place children in locations that minimize transportation challenges and provide support where possible.
